Ridgeway – JoAnne Murphy, age 70, of Ridgeway, passed away on Sunday, January 19, 2020 after battling kidney disease for many years.

The daughter of Joseph and Agnes (Cullen) Murphy, JoAnne was born on September 13, 1949 and raised in Ridgeway. She graduated as a proud member of the Class of 1967 and maintained lifelong friendships with her classmates. She went to the University of Milwaukee earning her Bachelors and Masters degrees, followed by further graduate studies at the University of Maryland, College Park.
