Dodgeville – Dennis M. Millard, age 80, of Dodgeville passed away on Thursday, February 16, 2023 at Agrace Hospice Center in Fitchburg.

He was born on February 9, 1943 in Livingston, a son of the late Alden and Mary (Knutson) Millard. He graduated from Iowa Grant High School in 1961. On June 30, 1962, he married Joan Wunderlin at St. Thomas Catholic Church in Montfort.
