Mineral Point - Donald G. Mundth, age 68, of Mineral Point passed away on Monday, March 17, 2014.

He was born June 29, 1945 in Fort Atkinson, WI to Donald G. and Betty (Ebner) Mundth. The family moved to Mineral Point in 1959, where he attended Mineral Point High School.
