



Donald S. Severson

October 17, 1927 - May 16, 2012

Chicago - Donald Sidney Severson passed away at the Bethany Retirement Home in Chicago on May 16, 2012, after a brief illness. He was born October 17, 1927, in Adams, Wisconsin. His mother Anne Stavlo Severson, and his father Sidney C. Severson preceded him in death.

Mr. Severson was a 1945 graduate of Mineral Point High school. After serving as a Sergeant in the U S Army, he graduated from Gustavus Adolphus College and The University of Wisconsin Law School.

His career as a corporate lawyer began at Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing in Minneapolis, followed by a number of years with Towers, Perrin Forrester and Crosby in Philadelphia. Mr. Severson has lived now for many years in Chicago, most of those years as a lawyer with the Borg-Warner Corporation. He was also known in Chicago as a collector and supporter of local artists' work.

His sister Carole Severson-Weiss, nephew Antonio, niece Maria, and six grand-nieces and -nephews, all of New York City, survive him.
