Dodgeville – Frederick L. Meudt, age 63, of Dodgeville, died unexpectedly on Saturday, February 15, 2014.

Fred was born on April 9, 1950 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Dodgeville, a son of the late Frederick W. and Marie (Hass) Meudt. He graduated from Dodgeville High School in 1968.
