Mineral Point - Fritz W. Aschliman, age 81, of Mineral Point passed away peacefully on Tuesday, September 29, 2020 surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on July 2, 1939 the son of Ernest and Frieda (Huber) Aschliman. He graduated from Ridgeway High School in 1957. He grew up on the family farm in Ridgeway and later enlisted in the Army Reserves. Fritz married Wanda Wonders on July 21, 1962. Fritz was in the farm machinery business for over 60 years. In 1981, he purchased Farmers Implement Store in Mineral Point and created a legacy for future generations. He enjoyed playing cards, attending sporting events with his grandkids, fishing trips to Canada with Mike Gratz and Roger Philipps and volunteering for missions trips to Mississippi. He enjoyed delivering equipment with his good friends Bert Cenite, Kenny Johnson and Mike Gratz. Fritz had many achievements; he was a Charter Member of the Mineral Point Lions Club, served as President and was Lion of the Year, he was a member of the Mineral Point Fire Department for many years, served as Board of Directors of Farmers Savings Bank, he was named Mineral Point Citizen of the Year, Cattleman's Association Lifetime Achievement Award, served on Board of Directors for Midwest Equipment and Dealers Association and he won many national awards for farm equipment sales.

Fritz is survived by his wife Wanda, his children Alice (Russ Skram) of Mount Horeb, Dan of Highlands Ranch, CO, and David (Krista) of Mineral Point.
