Blue Mounds / Dodgeville – Gordon J. "Gordy" Lehner, age 80, of Blue Mounds, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, April 1, 2015 at Bloomfield Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center.

He was born on June 5, 1934 in LeRoy, WI, the son of Edwin and Helen (Schaefer) Lehner. He grew up on a farm in rural LeRoy, with 3 brothers and 2 sisters. While a senior in high school, he was selected Wisconsin "Star" Farmer of the Year by the FFA. He graduated from Mayville High School in 1952 and joined his father in operating the family farm.

In 1955, at a skating rink in Fond du Lac, he met Leona "Lee" Fruehbrodt, the girl of his dreams and love of his life, and married her on August 31, 1957. He was a proud, hardworking farmer and spent most of his working life in the business of agriculture. He was a licensed pilot and avid fan of aviation.
