Platteville – Harold Vernon Williams, age 79, of Platteville died on Thursday, April 19, 2018 at University Hospital in Madison.

He was born on July 21, 1938 in Lena, IL, a son of the late Ernest and Edith (Atz) Williams. He graduated from Winslow High School in 1956. On May 31, 1956, he married Corrinne Rabe; they spent 38 years together until her death in 1994. Harold farmed in Stephenson County until moving to South Wayne in 1976.
