



Harry James Flanagan

August 27, 1949 - October 10, 2025

Mineral Point - Harry J. Flanagan, 76, passed away peacefully on Friday, October 10, 2025 surrounded by family at home in Mineral Point.

He was born in Dodgeville on August 27, 1949 to parents Cecil and Helen (Lawinger) Flanagan. He graduated from Mineral Point High School in 1967. He worked at Dicks supermarket for several years before owning his own grocery store, Countryside Market. He partnered with Jerry Marr before establishing his cattle broker business, Flanagan Livestock, in 1992.

Harry married Jean (Cruice) Flanagan on May 13, 1972 at St Joseph's Catholic Church in Dodgeville. Harry will be remembered by his friends, family, and community for his kindness, compassion, selflessness, generosity, and dedication to his people and his causes.
