Barneveld – James L. “Toad” Evans, age 86, of Barneveld, passed away on Saturday, February 5, 2022 at Upland Hills Health in Dodgeville surrounded by his loved ones.

Toad was born in Linden, Wisconsin to Edward and Sheba Evans (Vivian). Toad was a graduate of Dodgeville High School in 1954. He married Sharon on September 21, 1963, at the Congregational Church in Barneveld. Toad and Sharon were the proud proprietors of “Jones Hardware,” a four-generation family-owned store in Barneveld.
