Larry enjoyed a fulfilling career spent entirely at Darlington High School, forming lifelong friendships with his fellow faculty members. He truly enjoyed teaching, and his students. How many times we would hear "Oh you know Mr. Murphy? He was my favorite teacher!" Larry also taught Confirmation classes for many years. It was important to him to instruct the youth about their faith, and to lead them closer to the Lord. Larry was a humble and devout Catholic, and his faith was paramount to who he was. Farming was always a part of Larry's life. He and his brother Tom spent many years working together side by side on their adjoining farms.
