Dodgeville – Lawrence T. Sommerfeldt, age 85, of Dodgeville, died on Wednesday, August 25, 2021 at St. Mary’s Hospital in Madison.

He was born on November 4, 1935 in Belmont, WI, a son of the late Leon and Mary (Huggins) Sommerfeldt. He graduated from Mineral Point High School in 1953 and served in the U.S. Air Force from 1955 to 1959. On October 29, 1955, he married Patricia Leigh at St. Mary’s Catholic Church in Mineral Point.
