Dodgeville – Marcia Rae Gort, age 75 of Dodgeville, WI, passed away on Sunday, February 23, 2025 from cancer.

Marcia was born on August 25, 1949 in Mineral Point, WI at St. Joe's Hospital. She lived with her parents, older brother, identical twin sister, and younger brother on a farm in Jonesdale, WI. After graduating from Mineral Point High School in 1967, she completed the City College of Cosmetology beauty school in Madison, WI and worked in a beauty shop in Hollandale, WI.

She married Louie Gort in 1969 and they built a life together on a farm in Hollandale with their four kids. Marcia started working for Walmart in 1985 where she worked as a department manager in cosmetics, health and beauty, and pharmacy for many years. She retired in 2021.
