“Hi. I am the granddaughter of Jean Budd Edge, youngest daughter of Floyd and Letta Budd. I have some photos of Margaret as a child I would be happy to send to whomever would like them, they were in my grandmother's scrapbook.

I have a story to share, I hope it answers any questions you might have.

The family lore on this end is that Margaret was the daughter of Barbara Budd, and was raised by Barbara's parents - Floyd and Letta. Barbara was 16 when Margaret was born.

Barbara was sent out of state to a home for unwed mothers to give birth (so not in Wisconsin).

The rumor when the Budd kids were all alive was that a friend of Duane Budd's was Margaret's father due to a rape. Duane was 18/19 at the time.

However, Barbara told her children before she died that Duane was actually Margaret's father. That she had asked her parents for a lock on her bedroom door to keep Duane out and her parents refused. When Margaret was born, Floyd sent Duane to California when it came time to put the father's name on the birth certificate. He was afraid Duane would be in trouble with the authorities. He also insisted that Margaret not be given up for adoption, but raised by Barbara for penance (according to my grandmother). However, according to my grandma, Barbara would not do it, so Letta and Floyd raised her. I know that Barbara's children were so angry at their grandparents for allowing this to happen to Barbara, they no longer wanted keepsakes like their dishes (I know because they were given to me).

Please let me know if you would like the few snapshots I have of Margaret as a young girl.

If you'd like to see the family tree, I have quite a bit on ancestry.com. The tree is called Edge Fitzsimmons Barrett Donalson - and on ancestry I am "donhumb". I hope the truth brings some sort of peace.
