Dodgeville - Margaret Ann (McGraw) Lawinger, age 75, of Dodgeville, passed away on March 22, 2021 surrounded by loved ones after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer. She was born April 21, 1945 in Dodgeville and was the oldest of twelve children in the John and Kathryn (Brunker) McGraw Family. Being the oldest of twelve meant she was a second mother to many of her siblings and the righthand helper to her mother with the household responsibilities.

Margaret graduated from Dodgeville High School in 1963 and married Daniel E. Lawinger on April 3, 1964. They had 5 children and raised them on their farms in rural Dodgeville. Their first farm was purchased from Margaret's parents where Margaret was raised. Then they purchased their second farm from Danny's parents where he was raised. Margaret worked in the Dodgeville area as a waitress. She worked at the Wal-Mart Bakery until her retirement in 2019.
