In 1976 Mary became the full time Cook/Food Service Leader for the Center, a job she held for over 25 years while very rarely ever missing a day of work. She taught food service skills to over 100 people with disabilities while helping them to feel the pride of work success. Mary was named the winner of the Arc award for Hodan Center Staff Service in 1986, at the time becoming only the second person ever to have received this award. She retired from Hodan Center in 2001 as a beloved leader, co-worker, and friend who touched the lives of so many for over 26 years.*
