Mineral Point - Mildred Irene Stephenson, age 91, of Mineral Point, passed away Thursday morning, September 11, 2025, at Agrace Hospice in Fitchburg.

Mildred was born April 10, 1934, the daughter of John and Marion (Ferrell) Olson. Mildred graduated from Mineral Point High School in 1952 and married fellow classmate Leslie Stephenson in June of 1953. Together they raised 6 children on the family farm outside of Waldwick. Mildred and Leslie were lifelong members of the Congregational United Church of Christ in Mineral Point.
