everything – and he expected the people around him to do the same. That integrity was the backbone of who he was and how he raised his family.

Above all, Bob had a profound and unwavering love for his family and friends. He showed that love not always in words, but in presence – in the shared mornings at deer camp, afternoons on the pontoon, and evenings gathered together at the lake. He will be deeply missed and fondly remembered by all who had the privilege of knowing him.
