Mineral Point - Robert F. Terrill, age 85, of Mineral Point passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on Saturday, April 18, 2015 at Upland Hills Nursing and Rehab Center in Dodgeville.

He was born in Dodgeville on April 23, 1929 the son of John Floyd and Rella Mae (Ferrell) Terrill. He graduated from Mineral Point High School in 1947 and never missed an alumni dinner.
