Ridgeway / Dodgeville – Ronald W. Gilbertson age 88 of Dodgeville, formerly of Ridgeway, died peacefully in his sleep on Monday November 25, 2024.

He was born in Dodgeville on November 14, 1936 to Reuben and Isabel (Harms) Gilbertson and was raised on the family farm near Hollandale. He graduated from Barneveld High School in 1955 and served his country in Italy from 1955-1957 in the U.S. Army and continued in the guards until 1962.
