Dodgeville – Ronald Wesley Hunter, age 81, of Dodgeville, Wisconsin, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Thursday, July 28, 2022, at Upland Hills NHRC. Although Ron faced many health issues throughout his life, he never lost his faith in God and accepted his fate without complaint.
