Dodgeville - Scott L. Murn, age 63, passed away Saturday, October 31, 2015, at home surrounded by his family following a two year battle with cancer.

He was born on September 25, 1952, in Fort Atkinson to James C. and Helen (Wappler) Murn.

Scott studied mechanical engineering at the University of Wisconsin before meeting the love of his life, Marcia (Klosterman). They married on April 7, 1978, and settled in Dodgeville. In addition to being a loving father of four, Scott had a sparkling safety record over his 30-year career at UPS. He enjoyed playing and watching sports and was a talented drummer, having played in rock bands in his youth.
