Sue was a member of Grace Lutheran Church. She worked at several jobs in Dodgeville most notably at Anchor Bank, Carla's Cupboard, Iowa County Social Services, Land Conservancy of Iowa County and co-owner of the bar 'Here's to You' in Dodgeville and later in Mineral Point.

Sue was a special person to so many people and she loved you all. She was a strong,

compassionate, caring and loving woman and she will be dearly missed by those who knew her.
