Dodgeville - Thomas Francis Dolan, age 80, passed away peacefully with his loving family by his side after a long battle with cancer at Upland Hills Hospital on June 10, 2013. He was born on August 15, 1932, son of Mary Ann (Spellacy) and James Dolan in the Barreletown Township of Mineral Point, WI. Tom graduated from Mineral Point High School in 1951 and served in the U.S. Army stationed in Alaska during the Korean War.

Tom married Elizabeth (Betty) Straka in 1955 and together raised 8 children. He enjoyed farming for 35 years and was proud to share his passion with his sons. In 1988, he started a second career of almost 25 years with Lands' End. Tom was a man of faith and the most important thing was his family.
